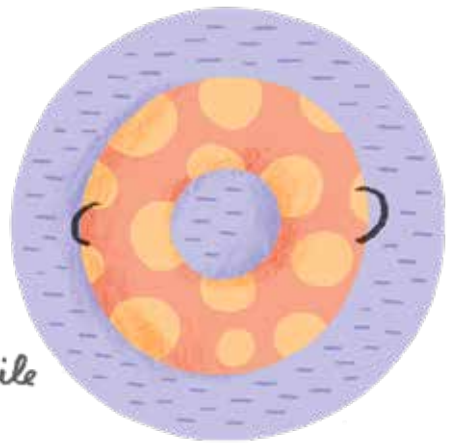




SEE DARWIN'S QUIRKY STREET ART

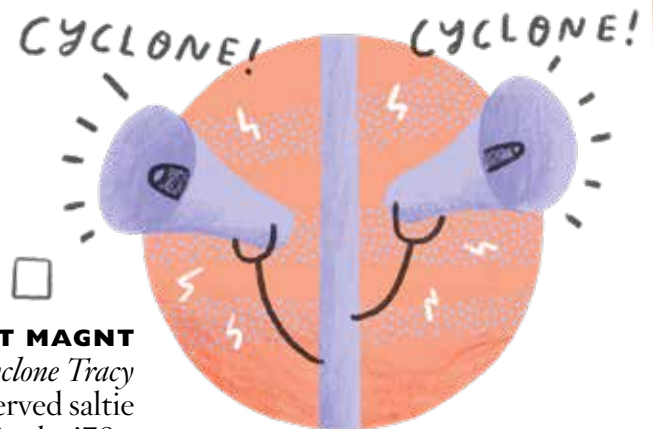

HEAR A CYCLONE WAIL AT MAGNT

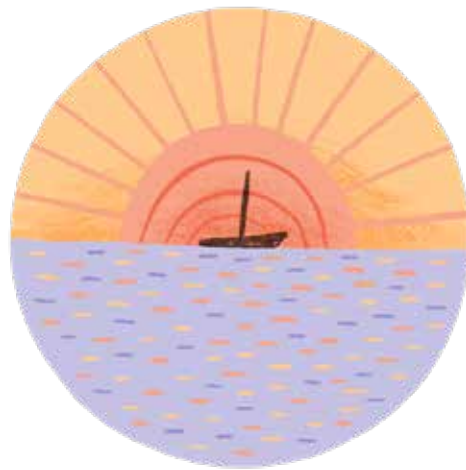

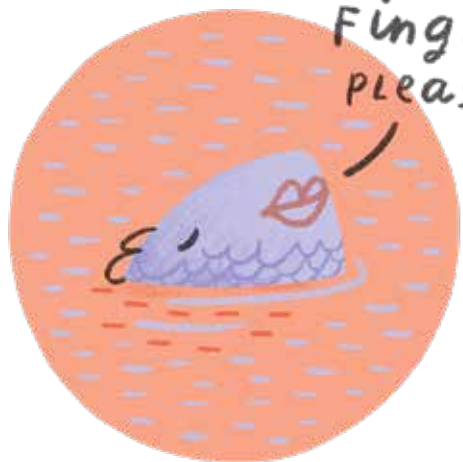
LEARN SOME SECOND WORLD WAR HISTORY

One FISH Finger, please.

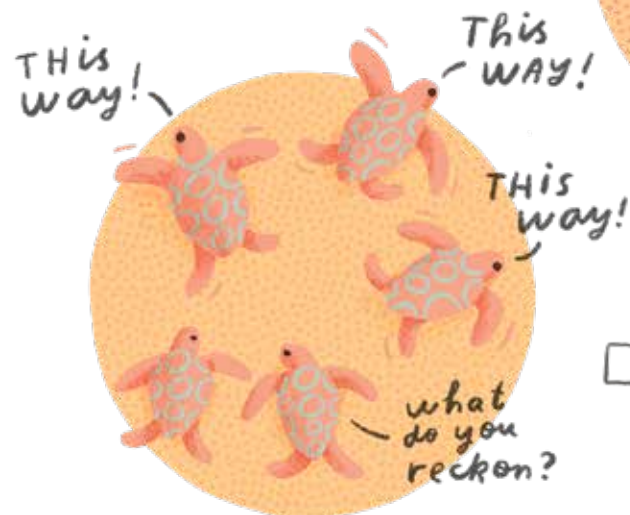
FEED THE FISH
