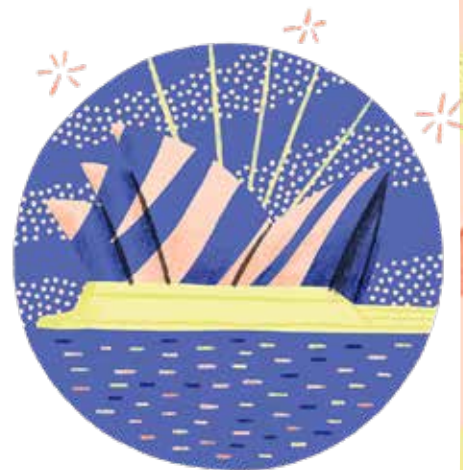




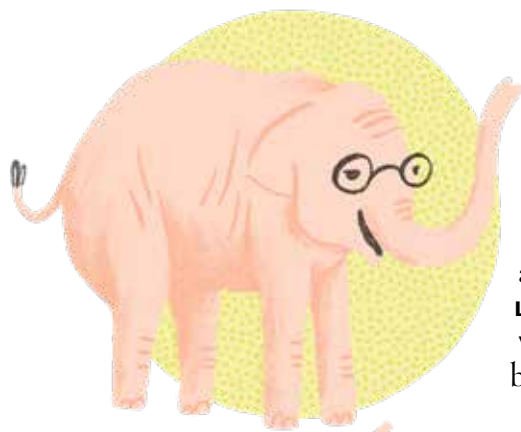
SEE THE LIGHTS OF VIVID SYDNEY

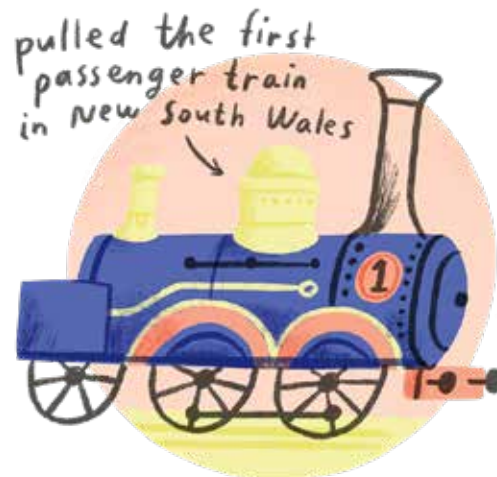

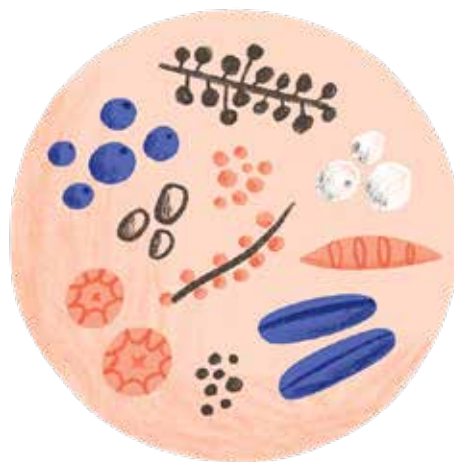
- SEE DINOSAURS AT THE AUSTRALIAN MUSEUM**
Travel back in time to learn about the fierce and funny dinosaurs that roamed the Earth some 65 million years ago. Before you leave, find your own (small and furry) dinosaur at the museum shop.



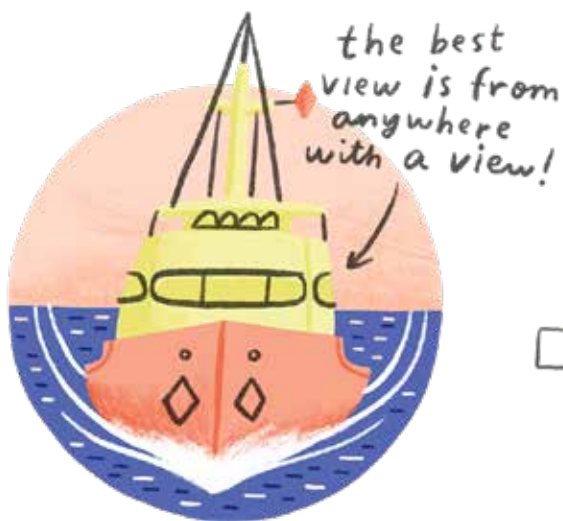
- SWEET DREAMS AT ROAR & SNORE**
Spend the night camping out at **TARONGA ZOO** listening to the nighttime chorus from the animals that live there. Don't miss out on your chance to hand-feed the giraffes while you are there.



- GO HUNTING FOR GHOSTS AT Q STATION**
Hear spooky tales at Sydney's former **QUARANTINE STATION**, said to be one of Australia's most haunted places. Ask your parents if you can spend the night... if you dare.



- FORAGE FOR SOME BUSH TUCKER**
Search for bush food and hear Dreamtime stories on an Indigenous culture tour at the **BOTANIC GARDEN, BARANGAROO** or **THE ROCKS**. Then eat what you find at morning tea in the botanic garden.



- CATCH A FERRY TO MANLY**
Cruise past the Opera House and out through Middle and South Head on the city's most scenic public transport route. Once you're there, be sure to stop for fish and chips for lunch.
